

Nitroglycerin (Nitrostat)

CLASS:	Antianginal
ACTIONS:	Dilates coronary arteries Dilates systemic arteries
INDICATIONS:	Angina pectoris Chest pain associated with MI Pulmonary edema Congestive heart failure Hypertensive crisis
CONTRAINDICATIONS:	Children < 12 Hypotension Hypersensitivity
PRECAUTIONS:	Constantly monitor blood pressure Syncope Drug must be protected from light Expires quickly once bottle is open



Do not administer Nitroglycerin (Nitrostat) if the patient has taken Viagra (Sildenafil), Revatio (Sildenafil) for Pulmonary Hypertention, Levitra (Vardenafil HCL) or a similar drug within the last 24 hours, Cialis (Tadalafil) within 48 hours.

SIDE EFFECTS:	Headache Dizziness Hypotension
DOSAGE:	1 tablet Repeat up to three times every 3-5 min

ROUTE:	Sublingual
