PEMS Updates	<p>PEMS Updates – Michael Player</p> <p>M. Player reported that the 2017 PEMS Protocol Update was almost complete and that the final filming, involving the obstetrical delivery and complications protocols was going to occur on Monday at the Hampton Campus of Thomas Nelson Community College. The school is providing the Council with the use of its OB simulator and staff to operate it.</p>		
Old Business	<p>a. Ketamine – C. Lawson reported that she had spoken with A. Burford of York County and C. Baker of Hampton but still had to speak to E. Erwin of James City County and C. Dunn of Williamsburg to get their input on the pilot project for using Ketamine for excited delirium. According to Dr. Lawson, she wanted all of the agencies using the PEMS RSI medication kits to participate in the pilot in order to increase the number of potential cases during the pilot. In this pilot, C. Lawson desired to place Ketamine in the RSI boxes so that they would be available to the agencies involved in the pilot. This had the effect of limiting the number of medication boxes that would have to be stocked with Ketamine. A discussion followed in which several</p>
