S. Parker stated that she submitted 2 to PEMS recently in reference to IV initiated by EMS to renal failure to a patient distally to a stent. ii. RHCC/VHASS Updates: S. Metzner stressed the importance of reporting diversion and bed status at least 1 time a day. Green > 75% monthly reporting; Yellow = 75-50% reporting; Red = <50% reporting in the month. He is available to come to agencies for assistance/training. Diversion is strong; Clinical is strong and continually monitoring for participation. PEMS region doing well on reporting. VA Hampton starting to complete Diversion and Clinical statuses as a new ED manager is working on it. Their ED is being remodeled. Navy Norfolk and Airforce at Langley is participating.
