New Business	<p>Cuffed Endotracheal Tubes (ETT). PEMS PPP and EMS Operations Committee would like to see if the pediatric ETT’s have all been changed to “cuffed”. Some of the agencies have moved to cuffed ETT and would like to see the PEMS Emergency Department Supply Replacement to reflect this. J. Bendit stated that not all agencies and hospitals are carrying cuffed across the region. He asked all Hospital systems if they all have moved to cuffed. Studies out there currently do not have a preference. M. 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	<p>intubated previously with uncuffed peds ETT, CHKD would immediately extubate and re-intubate with cuffed ETT and Riverside felt that they should prevent complications when this potentially could cause problems in the future. Some of the Peninsula agencies have moved to cuffed ETT only. B. Cumbie stated that they did not have all of the ETT cuffed in Sentara CarePlex. G. Samuels stated that Bon Secours MIH and RGH do not all have cuffed ETT. All agreed to keep this for old business to see if the region may move to cuffed only in the future. Currently the PEMS Emergency Department Resupply list does not specify one or the other.</p> <p>I-Gel supraglottic airway discussion- J. Bendit was emailed from several people from EMS Operations, J. Davenport and others about the future addition of I-Gels. I-Gels can be found at: <a href="https://www.intersurgical.com/info/igel">https://www.intersurgical.com/info/igel</a> None of the PEMS hospitals are using I-Gels at this time. King Airways were introduced regionally in the past and potential consideration for regional addition in the future. J. Bendit stated that the PPP, MAC, and EMS Operations should look at whether they would like to do with I-Gels for the future.</p> <p>Hampton Fire Department sent J. Bendit at PEMS email requesting blood pressure cuffs to be added to the PEMS Emergency Department Resupply list. This has been brought up in the PICO over past several years. The reason we have not moved to add this item to the regional resupply list is because all 55 agencies and 10 hospitals do not use the same blood pressure cuffs. It is unrealistic to ask hospitals all to by the various different blood pressure cuffs that are not universal. Some hospitals share the same cuffs as some agencies and have been providing them without adverse issues.
