Staff Reports	R. Blymyer advised that there is not a date set for the rescheduled Expo yet but that the committee would be advised when a date was set.		
Old Business	Committee advised that all protocols were presented to the MAC with changes made and agreed upon at the last PPP meeting. MAC and PPP will be receiving survey with draft protocols to provide the opportunity to review all draft protocols and make comments/suggestions on changes.		
New Business	<p>Uncomplicated delivery protocol- concerns voiced by T. Mitchell and B. Beam regarding safe transport of neonates with cord not being cut immediately upon delivery. Discussion held regarding recommendations regarding skin to skin contact and how to securely transport a neonate. Concern raised over OEMS regulations regarding securing all patients. Recommendation made to contact Mike Berg with OEMS to attempt to get clarification on subject. B Beam offered to contact vendor for pediatric transport device and have them attend next meeting to demonstrate device on the market for safe transport of pediatric patients.</p> <p>Narcan Administration by LEO- T. Mitchell brought to the committee's attention that there is a discussion going on in the region regarding law enforcement officers carrying and administering Narcan. Question raised about PEMS involvement and if there was room for us to be involved and offer support with supplying and restocking Narcan to LEOs and a potential exchange agreement. Committee unanimously agreed to stay uninvolved at this time and to keep up to date on the ongoing discussion.</p> <p>Pitocin- Angela Randolph from MIH presented the committee with the recommendation of considering prehospital Pitocin administration as MIH is now practicing routine administration of Pitocin as "active management of the 3rd stage of labor". Questions/Concerns raised over the cost and shelf life of Pitocin. Will contact L. Enzor for input on cost and shelf life.</p> <p>Electrical injuries- K. Carroll brought to the attention of the committee that the PEARLS in the electrical injuries are duplicated and need to be reviewed .</p> <p>Draft Protocol Survey- P. Hoyle discussed new format for reviewing draft protocols. All drafts have been compiled into survey to be sent out to MAC and PPP for review. All reviewing members will have the opportunity to offer comments/suggestions on drafts in the survey.
