Old Business	<p>Termination of Resuscitation- change guidelines to allow BLS provider to terminate CPR in field with Medical Control.</p> <p>Non-Narcotic Pain Management- including cold and distraction techniques. It was determined that oral nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory drugs and Toradol are not beneficial options in the prehospital setting.</p> <p>Behavioral/B52- Discussion for intervention of Agitated Delirium for the Paramedic Level add a box "Combining Haldol 5mg, Benadryl 50mg, and Ativan 2mg in a 3mL syringe.</p> <p>Isolation as a Procedure- Committee decided it was an agency specific issue mandated by the state, each agency having its own infectious control policy. No further action required.</p>	Present recommendations to MAC	D. Justis/ 6/8/17
New Business	<p>Hemorrhage Control- presented by B. Beam and K. Carroll: Head, Junctional, and Extremity Hemorrhage Control- hemostatic gauze, tourniquet use, possible diagram to be included in trauma section.</p> <p>EtCO2 in Sepsis Detection- presented by S. Craig: add EtCO2 guideline with lactate levels. Strong clinical correlation between lactate levels and EtCO2.</p> <p>D50 Shortage- presented by E. Vest: suggest 100 cc bolus of D10, considered safer for patient because lowers the risk of rebound hyperglycemia. ODEMSA: 100 mL bolus of D10>D50>Glucagon</p>	Present to MAC	D. Justis/ 6/8/17
