	<p>Stroke and Trauma Plans Reviewed/Revised for 3rd Quarter 2017 Hampton Roads Symposium was successful on April 21, 2017. Dinner with a Doc on May 3rd went well</p> <p>P. Hoyle reported the following: An incident where an ALS provider administered a second dose of Naloxone via IN route after 5 minutes instead of waiting 15 min for IN route. It was determined a change in protocol was not necessary- provider could have administered it IV, IO, IM, or Nebulized.</p>	Follow-up with agency/provider	P. Hoyle
Old Business	<p>Termination of Resuscitation- discussed and tabled due to statutes and White Paper recommendations.</p> <p>Non-Narcotic Pain Management- including cold and distraction techniques. It was determined that oral nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory drugs and Toradol are not beneficial options in the prehospital setting.</p> <p>Lopressor- Committee determined this is not currently needed therefore topic was dropped.</p> <p>Behavioral/B52- Discussion for intervention of Agitated Delirium for the Paramedic Level add a box "Combining Haldol 5mg, Benadryl 50mg, and Ativan 2mg in a 3mL syringe.</p> <p>Isolation as a Procedure- Committee decided it was an agency specific issue mandated by the state, each agency having its own infectious control policy.
