Staff Report	Contract Deliverables: PEMS submitted its contract deliverables and 4th Quarter Report for FY2019 to Virginia Office of EMS on July 1, 2019. The PEMS Redesignation site visit was held on 4-24-19. PEMS Redesignated July 2019.

	<p>D. Thomas presented 3rd Quarter of 2019 data on FMC to 12-Lead in last meeting. The average time from patient to 12-Lead has decreased to 9 minutes which is the lowest its been in a year. Highest time was 33 minutes. The lowest times were within a minute of arrival at patient...which was pretty phenomenal. It seemed that most career agencies are averaging very close to the 5 minute goal in the protocols.</p> <p>The 2019 Protocols became effective March 1, 2019.</p> <p>The Annual Governor's Award Nomination period is now closed. Award winners will be announced at the VAOEMS Annual Symposium in November 2019.</p>		
Old Business	<p>Mission Lifeline Awards for EMS: M. Doak reports that York County Fire & Life Safety has been notified that they will receive a Silver Award at the Virginia Heart Attack Coalition meeting on Friday, May 17, 2019. G. Samuels reports that Lancaster County EMS will receive a Bronze award for their STEMI performance as well. It is the first time for York and the second time Lancaster has gotten the award. M. Doak explains the Mission Lifeline award program. She reports that gathering all the data necessary for submission was a really big, time consuming job. Gary says that there were 22 agencies in Virginia and approximately 100 or so nationwide. Discusses that the biggest issue is that there isn't anyone feeding awards to the Virginia Heart Attack Coalition.</p> <p>J. Bendit emailed OEMS requested that "Time to 12-Lead Transmission" should be a required field for providers to enter the time of transmission. Currently it is a yes or no question. This was the hardest field to pull data from.</p> <p>Interfacility Transports/DIDO Times: Nothing new to report.</p>	Submit suggestion to OEMS to make Time to 12 Lead transmission boxes time based and required. New Business	<p>Hospital STEMI Data Reports for 3rd Quarter of FY2019 (April 1 – June 30, 2019). J. Bendit states she did not receive any STEMI Data Report forms reporting this quarter except by SWRMC. K. Harper states that its mainly time related. She stated that I should receive the data from Carneal, SueAnn and Jenny. Questions reference AHA Chest Pain Registry emailed after meeting. In the past, TEMS wanted to partner with PEMS to get the data but hasn't occurred. We cannot pull this data at PEMS currently. J. Bendit is working and gained access to Imagetrend Elite Report Writer and is working to pull quarterly data for STEMI, STROKE, and Trauma Triage Committees. J. Bendit is also working with VHASS and TEMS to see what reports can be used by PEMS that they have built already.</p> <p>Sal and Laurie questioned compliance with helicopter use in her rural area. They consistently try to educate about quick transport to facilities with little success. They feel need to have more education. K. Harper stated maybe she can schedule training with Dr. Chu or others to help increase use in their region.</p> <p>I-STAT discussion posed by email from M. Doak. Her initial discussion related to sepsis and wanted to bring to the STEMI Committee. She stated that M. Player wanted to talk about applicability and the possibility to bring to the DMAT. K. Harper stated that I-STAT Triponin have to be perfectly still and may still have variable results. False positives. She feels that this is not practical for use in the field. 	<p>Hospital for this 19 yo VCU provided temperature management on. He received bystander CPR on the scene by father and friend who was recently discharged with a full recovery. C. Beck stated that something that could have improved from this event was that when he QI'd PPCR, there were no rhythm strips. He was sent the EPCR from T. Prata and it did not have them either. M. Doak stated that you can ask providers in the ED to print the EKG from the cardiac monitor and that YCFLS has a new program that helps ensure Codes can have information for QI available. M. Doak stated she could provide information requested by C. Beck.</p> <p>C. Weissman states their goal as a HeartSafe community is to get CPR started as soon as possible. There seems some confusion in the community with regard to doing Hands-Only CPR. C. Weissman asks if there is any data or any success stories with folks using PulsePoint app. J.
