Old Business	<p>Mission Lifeline Awards for EMS: Nothing new this quarter.</p> <p>J. Bendit emailed OEMS requested that “Time to 12-Lead Transmission” should be a required field for providers to enter the time of transmission. Currently it is a yes or no question. This was the hardest field to pull data from. Unable to add according to OEMS.</p>		
New Business	<p>Hospital STEMI Data Reports for 3rd Quarter of FY2019 (July 1 – September 30, 2019). J. Bendit states she did not receive any STEMI Data Report forms reporting this quarter except by SWRMC and RRM. K. Harper states that its mainly time related. She stated that I should receive the data from Carneal, SueAnn and Jenny. Data collected from Imagetrend: 3 excel documents: STEMI Scene Time, PEMS FMC to 12 Lead, FMC to 12 Lead. Documents are different than hospital data sent. Providers that state STEMI in field should have a better percentage of 12 leads < 10 minutes than the shown 50%. Education to be provided during the Hospital education that is being conducted by Riverside and VCU to the agencies about STEMI, Stroke and Trauma Triage. S. Beam asked if we can send data requests to Emergency Department Nursing staff prior to meetings separate from the meeting invites. J. Bendit states he is sending request currently with this information but can separate individually.</p> <p>Sal and Laurie Messina retiring and will no longer be able to attend PEMS Committee meetings. J. Bendit stated that they have participated in the PEMS Committees for over 20 years.</p> <p>Reviewed last 18 months attendance on this committee. Dr. Gupta hasn’t attended over past 18 months.
