Staff Report	<p>Contract Deliverables: PEMS STEMI Plan due 3rd QTR. Discussion of recommended changes started by J. Bendit. It was recommended by SuAnn Carneal from RRMC, "I think that the Standard of care EMS FMC to device is 90 mins-not 120 minutes. See # 10 under Primary PCI Center and #2 under the EMS heading. Our goal is 90 mins E2B time. Thanks, Sue" G. Samuels looked up AHA Guidelines and C. Beck, and G. O'brien provided feedback. C. Beck Motion to make the change, "RAPID TRANSPORTATION: STEMI is a time sensitive emergency, with the current standard of care being First Medical Contact (FMC) to Balloon of less than 90 minutes. EMS providers <i>are</i> the first medical providers to out-of-hospital patients. All patients suspected of having a STEMI should be transported to the closest appropriate PCI-capable hospital within a 30-minute ground transport time. If transport time is greater than or equal to 45 minutes, then extend the EMS FMC to Balloon time to 120 minutes." Located on page 4 2nd paragraph under "Acute STEMI Patient Transport Considerations." 2nd by G. Samuels. Unanimous approval by the group.</p> <p>J. Bendit stated that the change from Bon Secours Memorial Hospital Richmond hospital to Mechanicsville hospital on page 7 along with the addition of Bon Secours St. Mary's Hospital (*) as a PCI capable hospital in Richmond.</p> <p>The 2020 Protocols become effective March 1, 2020.
