Old Business	<b>Mission Lifeline Awards for EMS:</b> Nothing new this quarter.  UPDATE: Going to MAC in September 2020 and potential start October-November for: O. Gossage initiated a follow-up discussion about transmitting Patient Name, DOB, and Past Pertinent HX prior to arrival to the ED when it is time sensitive, i.e. Stroke & STEMI. In March, the PEMS MAC decided that legally the HEAR is acceptable, the COR would be the best mechanism to share information in those situations. This discussion will be carried over to the Performance Improvement Committee and Trauma Committee for consideration.	To MAC	S. Craig/9-1-2020
New Business	<b>Hospital STEMI Data Reports for 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter 2020</b> (April 1- June 30, 2020).  Dr. Louka started as the PEMS Regional OMD and is the OMD for JCCFD. Since July 2020, he has been reviewing PEMS Protocols, Policies, and Procedures with recommendations for streamlining and making standardizations to help providers. One thing that needs to be addressed for the STEMI Committee is having a Cardiologist on the committee to review and have input. One Question is should we have new LBBB as a determining factor for EMS to call a STEMI in the field because this no longer meets standards in the ED. Should we leave this in the PEMS Protocols? O, Gossage stated she would get with Dr. Chu to see if he has a recommendation for this committee. She is not sure he has time to commit to this committee as the Cardiologist. J. Bendit request members solicit support from each facility to bring a Cardiologist to the committee to help drive information.  Review of the Imagetrend reports: Arrival to patient to 1 <sup>st</sup> 12 lead EKG : J. Bendit showed spreadsheet and 1 report took approximately 21 minutes. I was able to view narrative and nothing in narrative gave rationale. QI/QC was identified by agency and training occurred to help improve narrative. In this case, provider did not enter attempt EKG, but patient was vomiting which would not allow EKG to occur. Once vomiting controlled, EKG submitted. Total cardiac related incidents too numerous for this group to QI/QC all potential issues. One identified potential issue is that out of the total cardiac related incidents, Northern Neck had 40% EKG less than 10 minutes. This will be broken down to agencies to see if there is an issue that training may help. S. Craig and G. Samuels stated they can put an education piece together and go to the agencies that might be affected to help improve these.
