Old Business	Discussion regarding the current and growing list of drug shortages-  • Morphine (10 mg vials has slightly improved since last meeting)  • Haldol (has improved somewhat)  • Calcium Chloride  • Ketamine (Shortage reported across the Committee)  • Magnesium Sulfate  • Lidocaine  • Dextrose abboject  • Epinephrine  • Dopamine- anyone having to stock with norepinephrine?  • Amioderone shown to have shortages recently.  • Ativan  • Atropine  • Fentanyl  • 0.9 NaCL 100mL shortage started after Hurricanes in South East and Caribbean-09-2017. No substitute at this time. Shortages continue affecting larger bags.  Ketamine review from RSI Workgroup meeting: 1 June projected start supplying Ketamine. Restocking Agreement and Medication Box plans were reviewed and approved by the Pharmacy Committee on May 2 <sup>nd</sup> , 2018. They were then reviewed and approved unanimously as written by the MAC on June 14 <sup>th</sup> , 2018.  The Regional Medication Box Plan was reviewed prior to meeting due to the addition of the RSI Box. Committee voted and approved unanimously as written.  Reviewed PEMS Diversion Policy. Voted and approved unanimously as written.		
New Business	Bi-annual review of PEMS Medication Box Incident Reports. A review indicated that all had been addressed or are in the process of being addressed at the appropriate level(s). No action was necessary from the Committee. No Committee members brought up any other concerns or issues.  E. Elzarian made mention to the Committee of the nasal adrenaline that had been inappropriately put in several PEMS Medication Boxes instead of the Injection Adrenaline. S. Craig informed all pharmacists about the PEMS notification that was posted on the website and also distributed through the listserv.  T. Sledge reported that they only stock 10 mg Morphine at Riverside Regional, however they have been receiving boxes with 5 mg Morphine vials. He requested that when a provider comes in with one five, check with the pharmacy to see if they have 5 mg Morphine vials to restock the medication box.
