Staff Report	<p>Contract Deliverables:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> PEMS submitted its contract deliverables and 1st Quarter Report for FY2019 to Virginia Office of EMS on October 1, 2018. D. Thomas presents 1st Quarter of 2019 data on FMC to Depart Scene and FMC to 12-Lead. The average time from patient to 12-Lead was 9.5 minutes for the entire region only slightly better than last quarter. PEMS protocol states they must obtain a 12-Lead within 5 minutes...so we need to be doing EMS education to push 12-Leads as quickly as possible. It is still notable that we meet or exceed the AHA recommendation of 12-Lead within 10 minutes. Old Business	<p>C. Beck reported back on the status of the 17-year-old female cheerleader that presented to RDH with chest pain and abnormal ECG/STEMI presentation last quarter. She was transferred to VCU and determined to have myocarditis, not heart disease...discharged from VCU on day 3.</p> <p>D. Thomas reports no new movement on Mission Lifeline Awards for EMS. It was presented again at the Emergency Operations Committee meeting. K. Harper states she wants to make this an action item for the next meeting. M. Smith states that the Mission Lifeline Awards period opens Jan 1, 2019 and runs through March 30, 2019 so we need to make decisions before the nomination period opens. K. Harper and D.
