Staff Report	<p>PEMS is still in redesignation process- thank you to everyone who has helped.</p> <p>Now accepting Virginia State EMS Award Nominations. There is a fillable online form. J. Bendit stated that PEMS staff may contact award submission contacts for additional information to submit PEMS Regional award winners.</p> <p>Changes have been made to the PEMS Council. Debbie has retired and her position combined with Jeff's previous position is making 1 FTE starting 08-01-19. Seth's position had to make changes due to VAOEMS changes with the CE/Aux. programs. His 1 FTE will remain with some changes.</p> <p>J. Bendit stated that the PEMS Trauma Triage Task Force has changed to become the PEMS Trauma Triage Committee (TTC). L. Miller asked what differences are between the TF and Committee. J. Bendit stated that more information will be brought to the next meeting.</p> <p>Trauma data: L. Miller stated that TTC data look at to give to PEMS PI Committee. VAOEMS has not had a Statistician until recently. PEMS should be able to pull data. PEMS has had difficulties in obtaining reports from Statisticians at VAOEMS in the past. J. Bendit stated he has requested access to VPHIB/ImageTrend data. VDH/OEMS Quarterly Data on trauma incidents should be sent to PEMS. J. Bendit will research and get on the email list. Quarterly data highlights step 1,2,and 3 criteria transports to a level I or II facility. When the transports meet criteria for level I or II but the transport is to a level III facility, the TTC reviews whether appropriate and potentially why. Is it skewed data or not transported according to the Trauma Triage Criteria? Are these patients transported under triaged? J. Old Business	<p>Stop the Bleed survey results- Only 1 response.</p> <p>Stop the Bleed Initiative- J. Bendit stated that PEMS has held Stop the Bleed classes. S. Craig has taught 45 people. D. Belvin stated that they have taught 100s of people at JCCFD, YCFLS through their school systems. They are potentially making Stop the Bleed a requirement to graduate high schools. L. Miller stated that she is attending Longwood College Stop the Bleed training for teachers in the State of Virginia. Potentially putting in place Stop the Bleed with CPR to 9th graders every year. L. Miller stated that NNFD, VA. Beach have taught STB. She requests be obtain contacts and approximate locations and #s to determine needs to cover all areas. Gwen Brown is a professor at CNU and is making STB a requirement for her medical career classes. J. Bendit stated that GVRs is teaching STB on 09-19-19 at 7p.m. for anyone interested. L. Messina and S. Messina stated that they don't know of any STB TtT's in the Northern Neck. G. Samuels stated that currently the changes in owners and partnerships of Bon Secours keeps many projects on hold at this time. MIH and RGH are not currently Trauma Centers and STB has not been a priority at this point, may change shortly.</p> <p>L. Miller and TTC request contacts for STB in all PEMS Region.
